Frequently Asked Questions

Who can attend?

Students entering **Grades 3–9** are welcome to attend.

What instruments are offered?

Instruction is offered for **Violin, Viola, and Cello**.

Do students need prior experience?

No. **Beginners are welcome!** Students will be grouped according to age and experience level.

Are instruments provided?

Yes. **Free instrument rentals are available for beginners.**

Students who already own an instrument are encouraged to bring their own. Lockers will be provided for safe storage during the day.

What are the program hours?

Program hours are **8:30 AM – 2:30 PM**.

Drop-off begins at **8:00 AM**.

Pick-up is by **3:00 PM**.

Is lunch provided?

Students may bring their own lunch or receive free lunch provided by NYC DOE. Lunch service may be provided off-site.

Why attend both sessions?

The two-week format gives students more time to build skills, grow musically, and prepare for the culminating final performance on **Friday, July 17**.

Is there a final performance?

Yes. Students registered for both sessions will participate in a final showcase performance for family and friends.

How does the Refer-a-Friend Discount work?

What is the student-to-teacher ratio?
